Andrea Barbon works as Assistant Professor in Financial Technology at the Center for Financial Services Innovation of the University of St.Gallen (FSI-HSG) since 1 August 2022.



He teaches “Mathematics for Finance” to Ph.D. students and “Financial Technology” to master students. Born in Venice, he holds a Bachelor degree in pure and applied mathematics from the University of Padova, a Master’s degree in pure mathematics from the University of Amsterdam, and a Ph.D. in finance from the University of Lugano.

His research interests revolve around financial technology, with focus on decentralized finance, NFT markets, asset pricing, market microstructure, and monetary policy. He published in the Journal of Finance and the Review of Asset Pricing Studies. Beyond economics, finance, and math, his interests extend to sport, music, art, and blockchain applications.
